Version: 1.0.2. This pronunciation guide will be updated as additional books are released. Please take note of the version number to ensure that your version is current.

In multi-syllable words, the accented syllable is uppercase.

For the record, Gallant is pronounced Guh-LANT.

If you are unfamiliar with accented letters, here is a quick reminder of a few common uses:
